Standard MVR Guidelines

- 1. No Major Convictions in past five (5) years
- No more than a combination of two (2) minor moving violations or accidents in the past three
 (3) years or no more than two (2) minor moving violations and no accidents in the past three years
- 3. All drivers operating light to medium units must be age 21 or older
- 4. All drivers operating heavy or extra-heavy trucks or tractor-trailer units must be age 25 or older with at least three (3) years experience driving similar type vehicles with a valid Commercial Drivers License

Minor Violations

Failure to yield

> Improper towing

Following too closely

> Improper turn

> Illegal passing

Speeding (less than 20 MPH over limit)

> Improper lights

Unsafe lane change

Major Convictions

- > Driving under the influence of alcohol or narcotics (DWI or DUI)
- Illegal possession of alcohol or narcotics in a motor vehicle
- Refusal to take blood alcohol test
- Open alcohol containers
- Fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer
- Leaving the scene of an accident
- Reckless, careless, improper, or negligent driving
- Drag racing or speed contest
- > Homicide or assault through use of a motor vehicle
- Drivers who currently have a suspended or revoked license
